### PRESCRIPTION

#	Medicine	Dose	Frequency	Duration	Instructions
1	Paracetamol ( <b>Pain Reliever/Fever Reducer</b> ) Acetaminophen	500mg	Every 4-6 hours as needed	-	Take with water, do not exceed recommended dose
2	Amoxicillin ( <b>Antibiotic</b> ) Amoxicillin	500mg	Every 8 hours	-	Take with food, complete the entire course of medicine even if feeling
3	Metformin ( <b>Anti-diabetic</b> ) Metformin	500mg	Twice a day	-	Take with meals, if upset stomach occurs, take with food
4	Atorvastatin ( <b>Cholesterol-lowering medication</b> ) Atorvastatin	20mg	Once a day	-	Take at bedtime, with or without food

#### SYMPTOMS:

- **Fever** (A fever is a higher-than-normal body temperature, usually defined as 100.4°F (38°C) or higher. Fevers can be a sign of infection or another underlying condition.)
- **Cough** (A cough is a reflex that clears the airways of mucus, foreign objects, and irritants. Coughing can be a symptom of a cold, flu, pneumonia, bronchitis, or other respiratory conditions.)
- **Fatigue** (Fatigue is a feeling of exhaustion that can be physical, mental, or both. It can be a symptom of an underlying medical condition, such as anemia or chronic fatigue syndrome, or it can be a side effect of certain medications.)
- **Headache** (A headache is pain or discomfort in the head, scalp, or neck. Headaches can be caused by tension, migraines, sinusitis, or other medical conditions)

#### VITAL OBSERVATION:

**Blood Pressure:** 120/80 mmHg  
**Heart Rate:** 72 bpm  
**Respiratory Rate:** 18 breaths/min  
**Body Temperature:** 98.6°F (37°C)

#### NOTES:

- Take all medications as directed and do not skip doses.
- Avoid alcohol and grapefruit juice while taking this medication.
- If you experience any severe side effects, stop taking the medication and call our office immediately.
- If you miss a dose, take it as soon as you remember unless it is almost time for your next dose.
- Store the medication at room temperature and keep it out of reach of children.
- Follow up with us in 2 weeks to review your progress and check for any side effects.
