Medical History

- Past Medical Conditions
Mild gingivitis treated with dental cleaning

Vaccinations

- Vaccination and Booster Schedule
Core vaccines updated annually
- Injection Dates
Rabies - March 10, 2023, Feline Leukemia - March 10, 2023
- Type of Vaccine (Feline Panleukopenia, Feline Herpesvirus, Feline Leukemia, Rabies, etc.)
Rabies, Feline Panleukopenia, Feline Herpesvirus, Feline Leukemia
- Veterinarian's Stamp and Signature
Stamped by CityVet Clinic, signed by Dr. Sarah Thompson

Parasite Treatments

- Internal Parasite Treatment (Deworming)
Dewormed every 3 months, last treatment on January 5, 2024
- External Parasite Treatment (Fleas, Ticks)
Monthly flea and tick treatment, last applied on February 1, 2024
- Products Used and Treatment Frequency
Advocate (spot-on) for fleas/ticks, Drontal for deworming



Diet and Weight Tracking

- Type of Diet (Kibble, Wet Food, Raw Diet, etc.)
Mix of high-protein dry food and wet food (chicken-based)
- Daily Ration
70g dry food + 100g wet food per day
- Weight Tracking Chart
Current weight: 4.8kg, stable over the last 6 months

Veterinary Examinations

- Check-up Dates
Last check-up on March 5, 2024, next scheduled for September 5, 2024
- Veterinarian's Observations and Recommendations
Good overall health, advised regular dental care
- Test Results (Blood Tests, Urinalysis, etc.)
Blood test (March 2024) - normal values, no abnormalities

Behavior and Well-Being

- Habits and Lifestyle
Indoor cat, enjoys climbing and playing with feather toys
- Behavioral Issues (Aggression, Stress, Marking)
Occasionally stressed when visiting the vet, no aggression or marking issues
- Enrichment and Training Advice
Daily play sessions, cat tree for climbing, puzzle feeders for stimulation

Emergency and First Aid

- Emergency Veterinary Contacts

- Warning Signs Requiring Consultation
Loss of appetite for more than 24 hours, vomiting, lethargy, difficulty breathing
- First Aid Measures for Accidents or Poisoning
Keep cat calm, avoid giving food, call emergency vet immediately

No major health changes since the last visit, active and playful
- Notable Changes (Appetite, Activity, Behavior)
Slightly reduced appetite during hot weather, but still within normal range
